Today the only types of batteries in the United States that contain mercury are button cell batteries and mercuric oxide batteries. The Mercury-Containing and Rechargeable Battery Management Act of 1996 prohibits the use of mercury in all other types of batteries.

Are button cell batteries Mercury free?

The Mercury-Containing and Rechargeable Battery Management Act of 1996 prohibits the use of mercury in all other types of batteries. With the passage of this act, mercury-free alkaline batteries became the national standard for most types of batteries. Button cell batteries are miniature batteries in the shape of a coin or button.

Do home battery cells contain lead or mercury?

No, home battery cells do not contain lead or mercury. Button cells may contain mercury. Current batteries can have heavy metals like lead, cadmium, and lithium. Responsible disposal is essential to prevent environmental harm. Always check battery labels for safety information and details on components like zinc, manganese dioxide, and graphite.

Are lithium batteries based on Mercury or cadmium?

Many are based on zinc-manganese or lithium ions; neither contains heavy metals. Both in Switzerland and in the EU, the trade and sale of batteries containing mercury (chemical: Hg) or cadmium (Cd) are severely restricted. There is a limit value for mercury in batteries of 5 mg/kg and of 20 mg/kg for cadmium.
